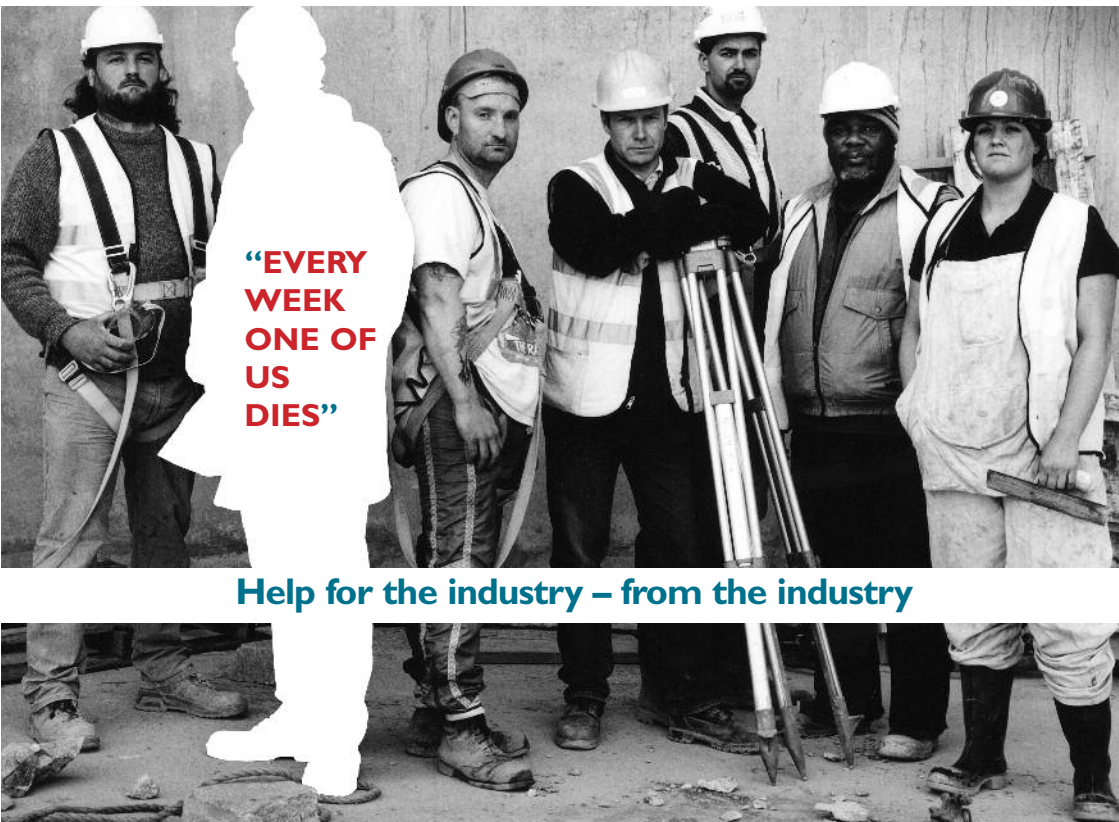

Designer Awareness Days are run by the industry for the industry. Working Well Together (WWT) is the cross-industry partnership with the aim of improving standards of health and safety in our industry. The goal is meaningful and sustained reduction in injury and ill-health. The benefit is not only a reduction in the pain and suffering caused to our fellow workers. There are also real gains to be made in productivity, pride and professionalism.

Designers have a big influence on all of these factors. Early consideration of health and safety issues can resolve many of the problems that contractors face. We all know that changes cropping up during the construction phase can be expensive. The cost of failure to plan effectively is reflected in the high levels of injury and ill-health amongst our workforce.

There is widespread concern that designers are not doing enough to address, mitigate or eliminate risk. Some designers are not fully aware of what they need to do. Many design risk assessments are too simplistic and not effective in reducing high-risk situations. Too many people with design responsibilities have not had the necessary training in health and safety and, as a result, fail to fully understand how to meet the standards expected of them. Designers have a crucial role in improving the performance of the industry, but they need to be more proactive.

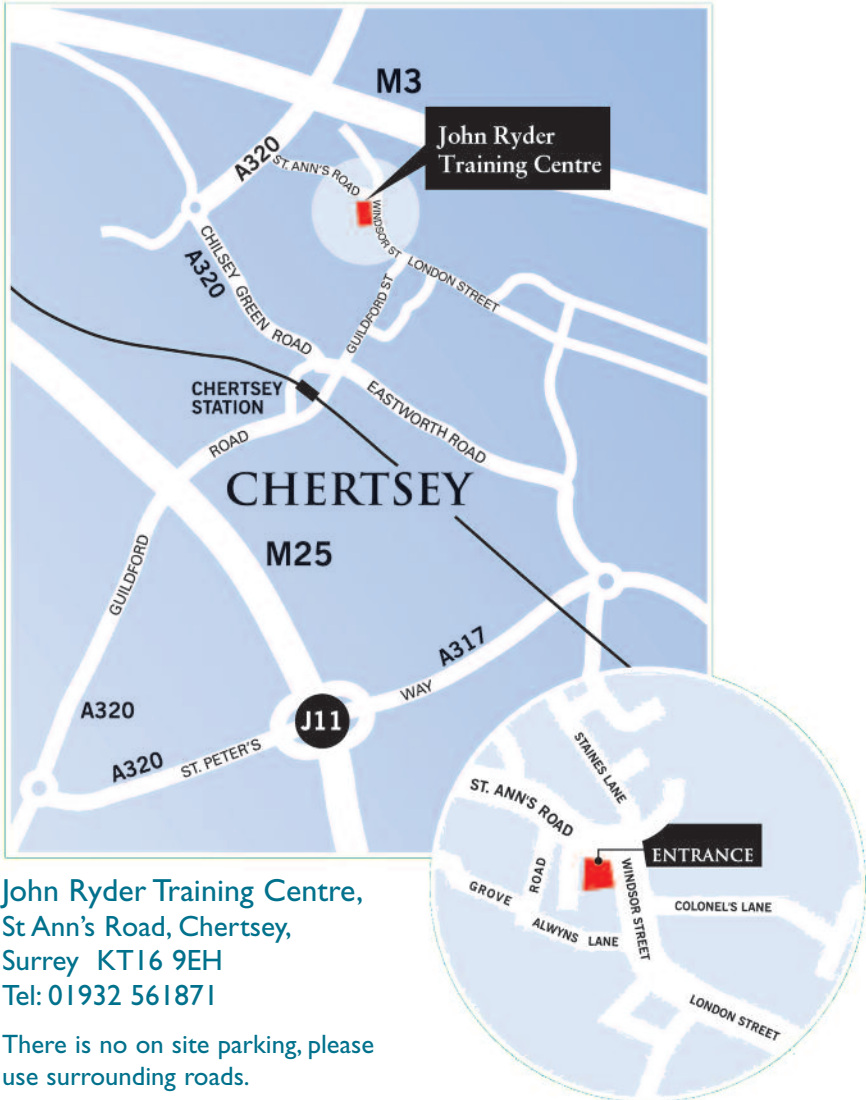
